- Try to avoid wearing expensive jewelry or watches in public or that can be seen while driving. A number of follow-homes are believed to have been a result of these eye-catching items.
- Have keys available to either jump into your car if someone approaches you or to enter your home with.
- Always trust your instincts. If someone seems unusual, it probably means there is something going on.
